

Seismologists have classified 59% of India's landmass as earthquake prone



Among major cities, **Guwahati and Srinagar are located in the very high risk zone while Delhi is in the high risk zone.** Mumbai, Kolkata and Chennai
are in the moderate risk zone. **The Bureau of Indian Standards has grouped the country into four seismic zones.** Starting from zone V (most active),
the grading goes down to zone II (least active).
A seismic coefficient is calculated for each zone,
which should be adopted for designing buildings
